CHANGES TO TRANSFER DUTY

MAIN TAX PROPOSALS:

The rates and brackets for transfer duties on the sale of property will be adjusted to provide relief to middle-income households. The new rates eliminate transfer duty on properties below R750 000, while the rate on properties above R2.2 million will increase.

ARE YOU THINKING OF BUYING? SOME POINTS TO REMEMBER (PART 1):

Have a walk around the outside to see what the general maintenance is like, and if the house

been well cared for. Is the swimming pool clean, is the garden neat, does the front gate properly? These are all telltale signs if the house has been well maintained.

- Start with the roof. The steeper the pitch, the less trouble you are likely to have with it. Flat if will give far more trouble and in most instances will have a shorter life span. Roofs with parapeter more likely to give damp problems than roofs where eaves cover the walls.
- Concealed gutters are a definite no, but even exposed gutters need to be checked for leaks sagging.
- Try and spot the hot water cylinder overflow. If it's dripping heavily, know that there are prob
 that are going to need attending sooner than later.
- Check to see if the doors and windows appear to be sealing properly, and that there are no
 between the frames and surrounding walls. It is easy to spot if the timber has been well mainta
 if it looks tired and grey, you are in for some serious sanding and painting.
- Check the walls for cracks, especially look for signs that cracks have been filled and painted over
- Look for large trees with extensive root systems especially if they are located next to walls, as t
 can cause long-term problems. Check to see if boundary walls are starting to tilt slightly, a sure
 that those roots are having an effect.
